Workshop for pupils in school year 7 (age 13) and above

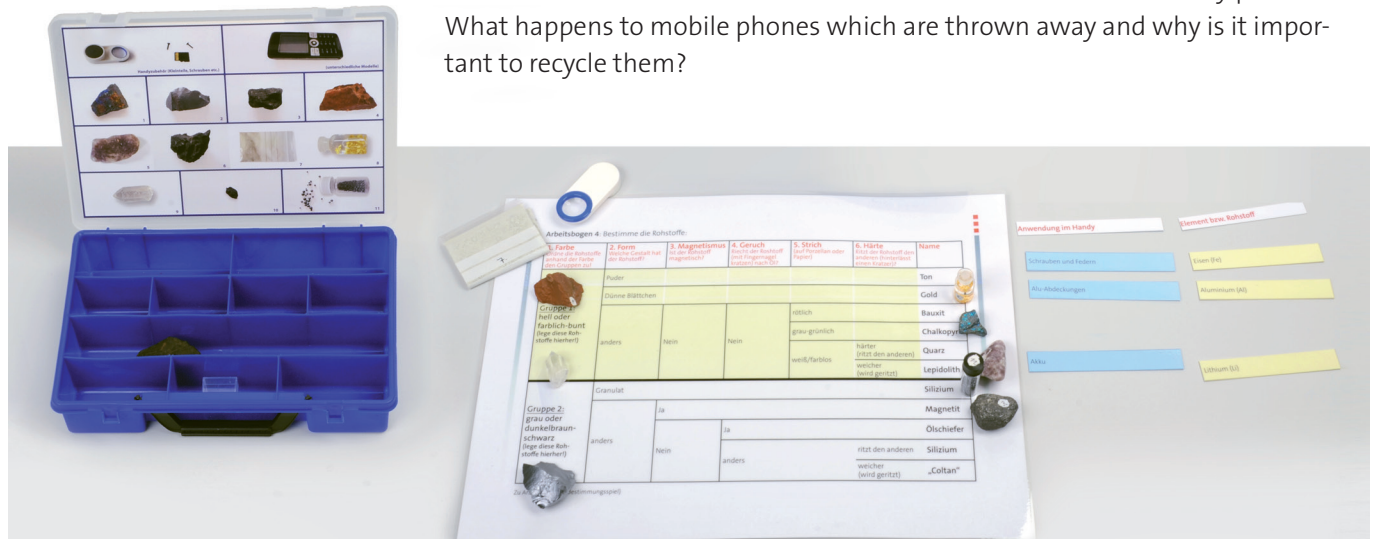
Following a guided tour of the exhibition, the school children work together in small groups.

Guided Tour

This guided tour through the mineralogical galleries shows a selection of minerals and explains how they and other raw materials are extracted from the Earth.

Workshop

The pupils then move on to the workshop part, where they can dismantle and take a closer look at mobile phones. They work together in small groups and try to answer questions about raw materials such as: How many and which different raw materials are in a mobile phone? Why can some of them not be replaced by other materials? Where do these raw materials come from and under which conditions are they produced? What happens to mobile phones which are thrown away and why is it important to recycle them?
